The report must include three basic parts: 1) a narrative of your accomplishments, 2) a financial accounting of expenditures, and 3) a 60-second video describing the impact of the project. Please address in your report all of the items listed below. Please note that failure to submit this report will make you ineligible to receive a grant from the NEA Foundation in the future.

Narrative Section

- How has this project enabled you to test creative new ideas or innovations related to your teaching practice?
- In what ways did your project impact the learning experience and outcomes of students?
- How did this project advance students' cultural learning and appreciation, anti-racism commitments, and/or understanding of civics and democracy?
- Approximately how many students directly benefited from the professional learning within the duration of this project?
- (Optional) Please provide any suggestions you may have for the NEA Foundation's future design of the *Envision Equity Grants* program.

Financial Section

- In a Word, Excel, or PDF attachment, provide a description of each expense, the amount expended on each item, and the amount and source of any matching funds.
