Student Success

The report must include three basic parts: 1) a narrative of your accomplishments, 2) a financial accounting of expenditures, and 3) a 60-second video describing the impact of your project. Please address in your report all of the items listed below. Please note that failure to submit this report will make you and your partner(s) ineligible to receive a grant from the NEA Foundation in the future.

Narrative Section

- How did this project support deeper learning and the development of skills for students?
- What were your goals for this project? How did you evaluate results and what were the outcomes of this project?
- Approximately how many students directly benefited from this project?
- Describe any challenges you encountered in completing your project and how you addressed them.
- What was the most important thing you learned during your project?

Financial Section

- In a Word, Excel, or PDF attachment, provide a description of each expense, the amount expended on each item, and the amount and source of any matching funds.

Additional Materials

- Please attach a 60-second video describing the impact of this project on your teaching practice and/or student learning. Please do not include any images of students in the video.
